



SAFETY RULES

- All persons on site must have completed and comply with OHS WorkCover general induction.
- Before starting work, all personnel must do a site specific induction.
- Safety footwear and hard hat are to be worn at all times whilst on site (excluding designated areas for meetings and meals)
- Toolbox talk meeting is to be held each day at during the morning tea break.
- All incidents are to be reported to the site representative. All injuries to be discussed at the at the following Tool Box meeting.
- All personnel to sign-in on entry to site, report to site representative and sign-off when leaving.
- No fencing to be removed without prior knowledge and consent from PJC Group representative,

- All materials to be kept within the confines of the barricades.
- No boring of bores without the prior knowledge and consent from PJC Group representative,

- Site Traffic & Pedestrian Interaction Management Rules: All traffic and pedestrian movements will be managed at site in line with the sites traffic and pedestrian interaction management rules or as directed by the Principal Contractors Nominated Representative.
- Safety Glasses, gloves and ear plugs are to be worn when necessary.
- *Glass Containers:* Glass containers are not allowed on site, other than in lunchrooms.
- *Alcohol and Drugs:* The consumption of alcohol and all illegal drugs are prohibited from site.
- *Incidents:* Incidents and injuries must be reported immediately to the site representative in charge.
- *Fire Prevention:* Fire prevention must be employed by all persons, an appropriate fire extinguisher must be on hand for each welding set bought onto the site.
- *Plant:* Every owner of plant shall ensure leads and power tools are inspected and tagged by a licensed electrician prior to their use and thereafter at monthly intervals. All details of their inspection are to be recorded in a site log book. Details on the tags and in the log book shall



include the license number of the electrician, date of inspection and the owners plant number of the item inspected.

- *Chemicals and Hazardous Substances:* Chemicals and hazardous substances must be used and stored in compliance with Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS).
- *First Aid:* All persons requiring first aid treatment are to contact first aid officer on site. They will treat and record injury in the WorkCover register of injuries.
- Work Areas must be clean and tidy at all times. Safety hazards are to be cleaned up promptly.
- All temporary electrical work must comply with the WorkCover Code of Practice for electrical Practices or Construction Work.
